

Submit Your Virtual Solution

To have your solution seen and scored by OM Officials, teams must submit the following by their tournament registration deadline. *Check with your local association for registration and submission deadlines!*

Teams submissions will come in the form of three filesharing links, copied to your team registration.

The team will be required to submit:

- One video performance link
- One video explanation link
- One combined additional photographs link
- One combined paperwork link

You can update your video and paperwork as often as needed, until the deadline.

These files will be uploaded to the team's preferred file sharing site (Google Drive, Microsoft, YouTube, etc.), which will then generate a shareable link that teams will copy and paste onto their online registration form.

Video Link

Teams will upload their performance and explanation videos ([specifications for which can be found here](#)) to any file or video sharing service as long as it provides a link to view the solution. **Be sure your sharing settings allow officials to view it.**

- The videos must be uploaded to a file sharing service of your choice (Google Drive, Microsoft, YouTube, etc.) provided it is publicly accessible in the USA.
- Create a shareable link for the video and paste it into the appropriate field after your team logs into the Members Area. **Be sure your sharing settings allow anyone with the link to view it.**
- Do the same with your paperwork, photos, and team picture as described above. Check and double check your sharing settings for all so the judges don't miss an aspect of your solution!
- Be sure to check the email used during team registration regularly for any communication from the judges during the tournament.

Photo Link

You may submit up to **10 pictures of your solution and 4 Style pictures**, but they must be all in one file and should be uploaded as a PDF. One suggestion– copy and paste each picture into a document (captions welcome!) and either save as a PDF or Print to PDF.

Upload the combined PDF file containing all of your photographs to the file sharing service of your choice and copy the shareable link onto your registration form.

Paperwork Link

The Team List, Style Form, Cost Form, Outside Assistance Form, and anything else required by the problem should not be part of the solution + explanation video. These documents will be downloaded below, completed by the team, and combined as a single document to be submitted for judges. Additional details below.

All teams are encouraged, but not required, to submit a performance script. Subtitles edited onto the recording are not allowed.

All required paperwork **MUST BE** combined and uploaded in a **single** PDF file.
