

The following applies to teams participating in a Virtual Tournament and addresses team submission of two videos and a file of photos.

Read “Virtual Tournament Procedures”

- 1) 8 mins limit on the video of the Long Term (LT) performance
  - a. This must be a continuous video, no editing. The person recording may move around.
  - b. Capture all **required scoring elements** – required elements that are scored objectively; performance and style elements that are scored subjectively. Judges cannot score what they do not see or hear in the video
  
- 2) 7 mins limit on then video of the **Team Explanation**
  - a. This video may be edited.
  - b. This video experience replaces the post-performance period when the judges ask questions to the team members.
  - c. Use this opportunity for the team members to **show case** team creativity, energy, teamwork. Consider brief explanations of inspirations, overcoming design and implementation challenges, mutual encouragement, etc. Emphasize acting or creative action that resulted making an impact (making a significant difference).
  
- 3) Photos
  - a. The instructions limit the number of photos that can be submitted.
  - b. These photos assist the judges in evaluating objects for creativity, or
  - c. **Compose photos.** Make the most of each photo.
  - d. Suggestions: (not comprehensive)
    - i. On required and team-created style elements highlight attention to details, the moment when the item is best illustrated in the long term performance
    - ii. Examples of the versatility of the set and props
    - iii. Attention to detail on the costumes and props
